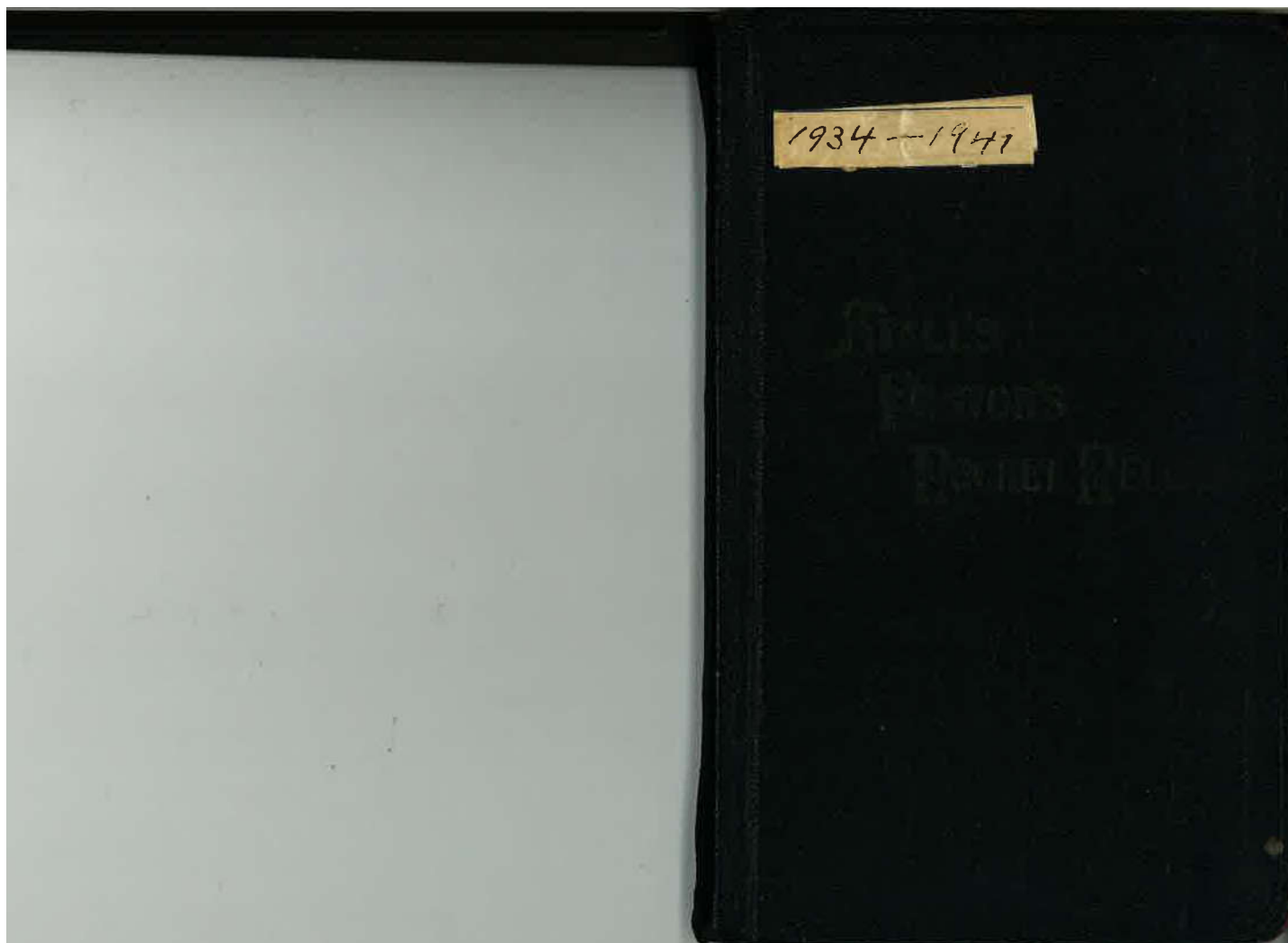
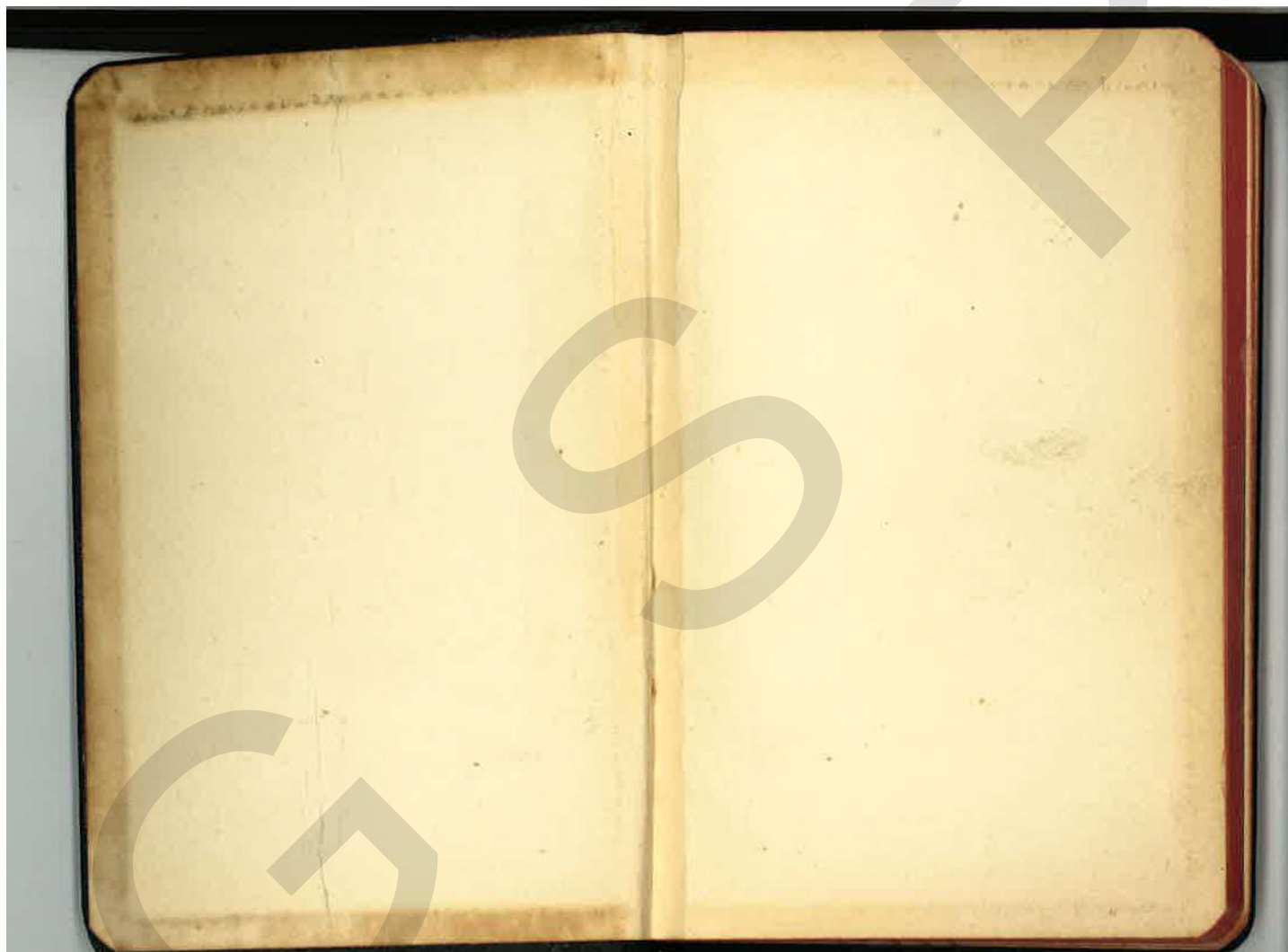
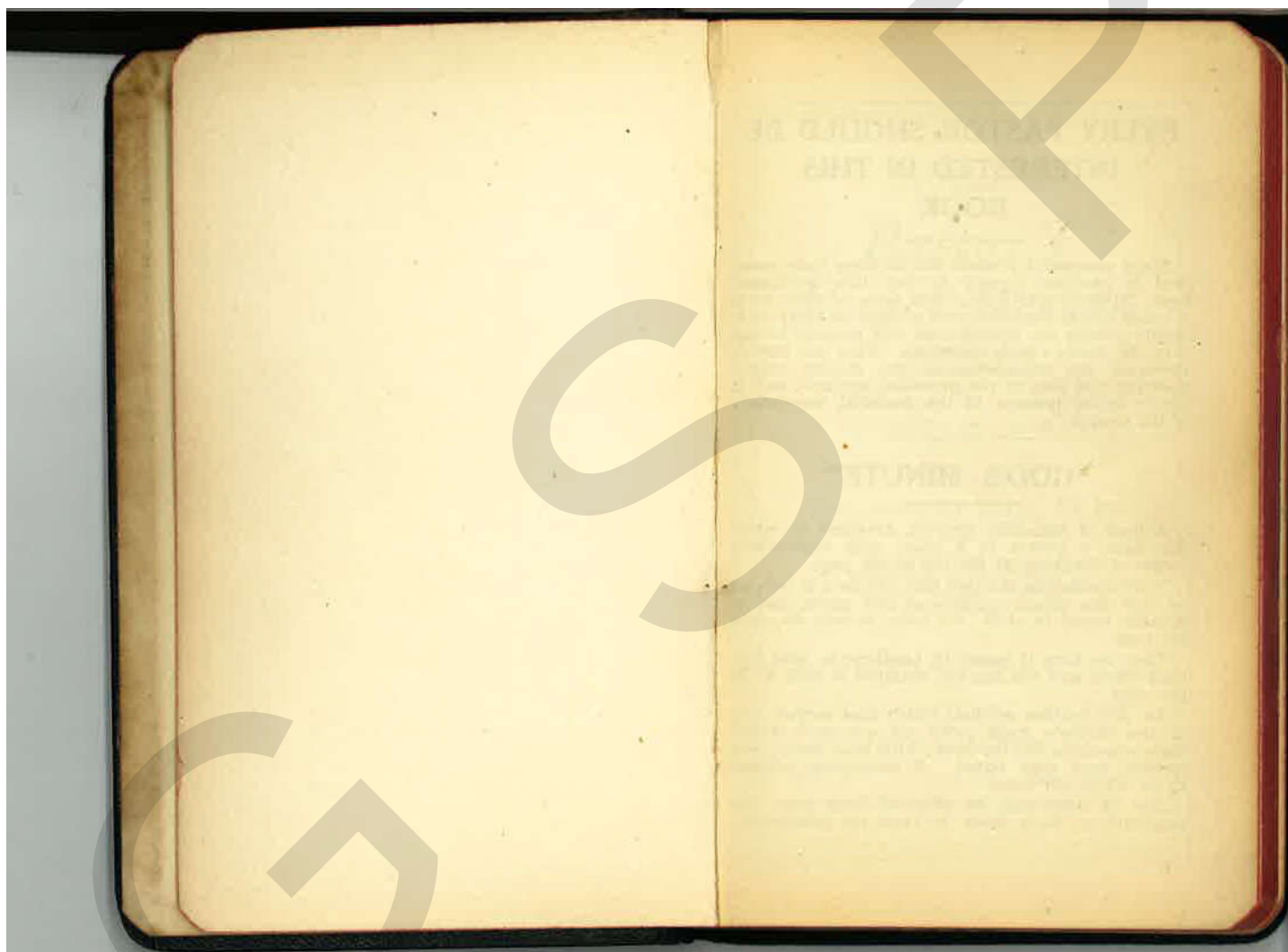








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This book is sent out to supply a want felt by ministers of every denomination. To most pastors each volume will afford sufficient space to record the work of about two years. When full, the record may, at any time, be continued in another volume, thus enabling a minister to preserve a condensed record of his entire ministerial career.

The various departments explain themselves, and it only remains for me to offer a few

SUGGESTIONS.

Arrange names of "members" and those included under head of "clerical calls," alphabetically, with surname written first—e. g., Washington, George. There is space sufficient for recording the names of 714 members, and where circumstances will allow after B. and S., leave at least 15 lines. After O. F. K. L. M. and W., at least 10 lines. After all other letters, at least 5 lines.

In recording date of "Calls," place the year at the head of columns, and designate date by figures—e. g., 9, 26 meaning ninth month, twenty-sixth.

"Sermons Preached."—Designate written or extempore sermons by the initial letter. The record of any sermon, previously preached, may be readily found by tracing rapidly the column designated "Book." "Prayer-meeting Lectures," and like discourses may be recorded regularly among the sermons, or the last six or eight pages of the department of sermons, Preached, may be set apart for each record, as may be preferred.

"New Members."—This department is intended to afford a complete record of names of all persons received into the church, so that a minister may know at the close of his ministerial career, not only the number, but the names of all persons whom he has received into the church.

"Cash Received and Paid Out" is designated for the larger receipts and disbursements.

"Journal of Prominent Events" will, when properly kept, afford the dates of settlement in new field of labor, laying of corner-stone or consecration of church, seasons of special religious interest, etc.

The "Tabular Summary" will exhibit a resumé of work, which may be recorded quarterly, semi-annually or annually, as each may elect.
